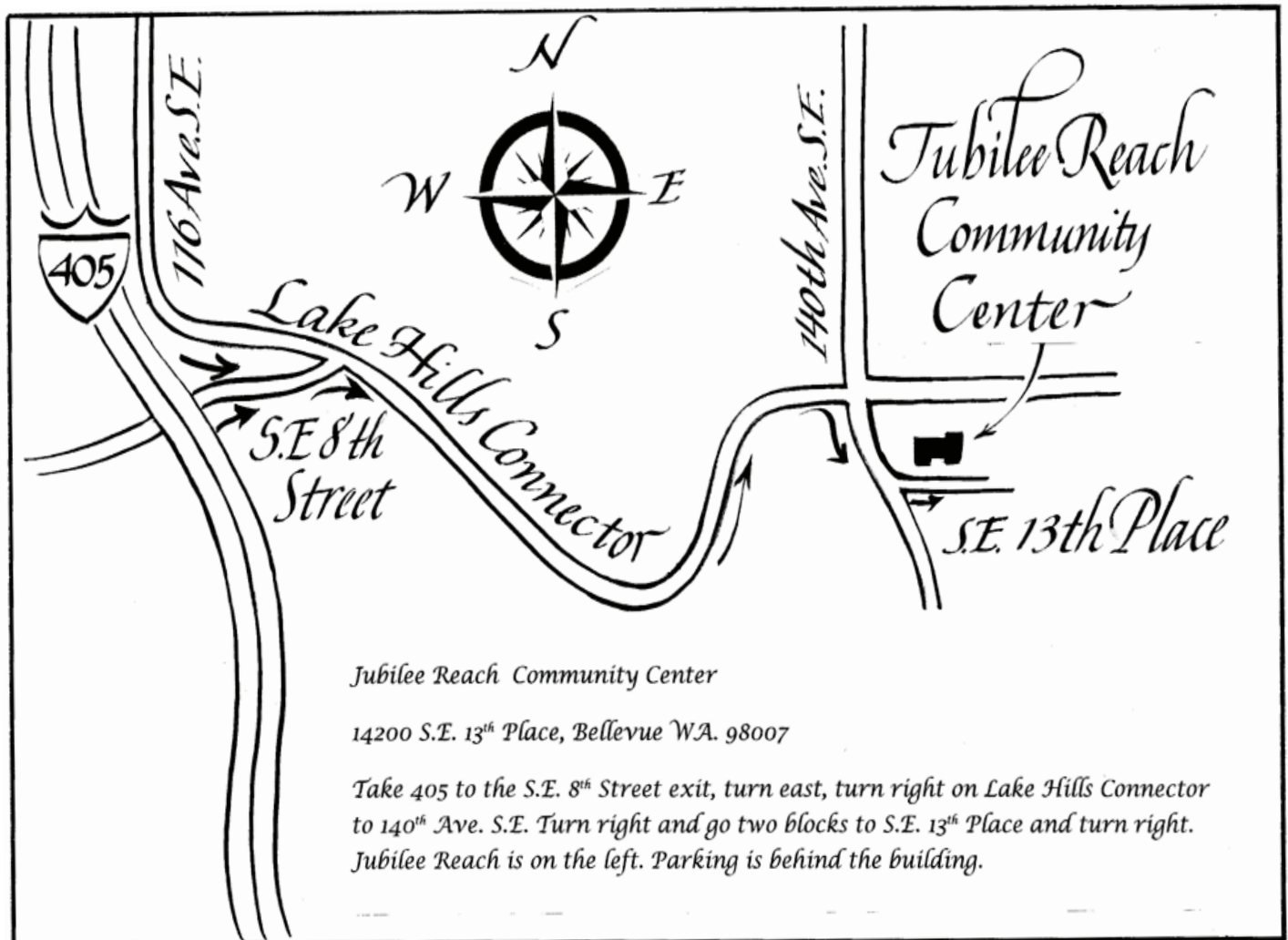

Meetings in 2018

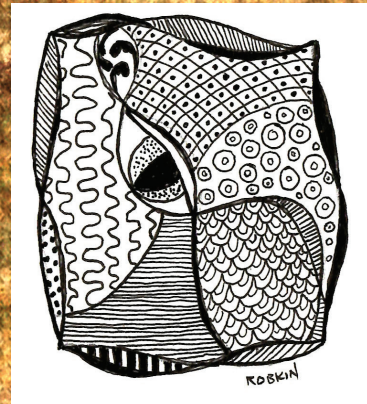
January 18 Meeting: Narnonian Hand with Teri Kruger

Terri Kruger will be teaching Narnonian Hand, a fun and versatile variation of Pointed Uncial, great for beginning and intermediate calligraphers. We will cover basic letterforms, border, color and shading techniques and learn how to write on a variety of surfaces, such as glass, fabric and leather.



February 15 Meeting: Zentangles with Nan Robkin

Zentangles are an elaborate form of doodling. Using Micron (or similar) pens, we will create small black-and white works of art on 3" square tiles.



March 15 Meeting-Watercolor Gems with Linda O'Neill

After exploring a number of monoline variations, participants will design a short quote of their own choosing. This quote will be transferred to 4" x 4" watercolor paper squares and completed with a glaze pen and watercolor. The finished piece will be framed.
