

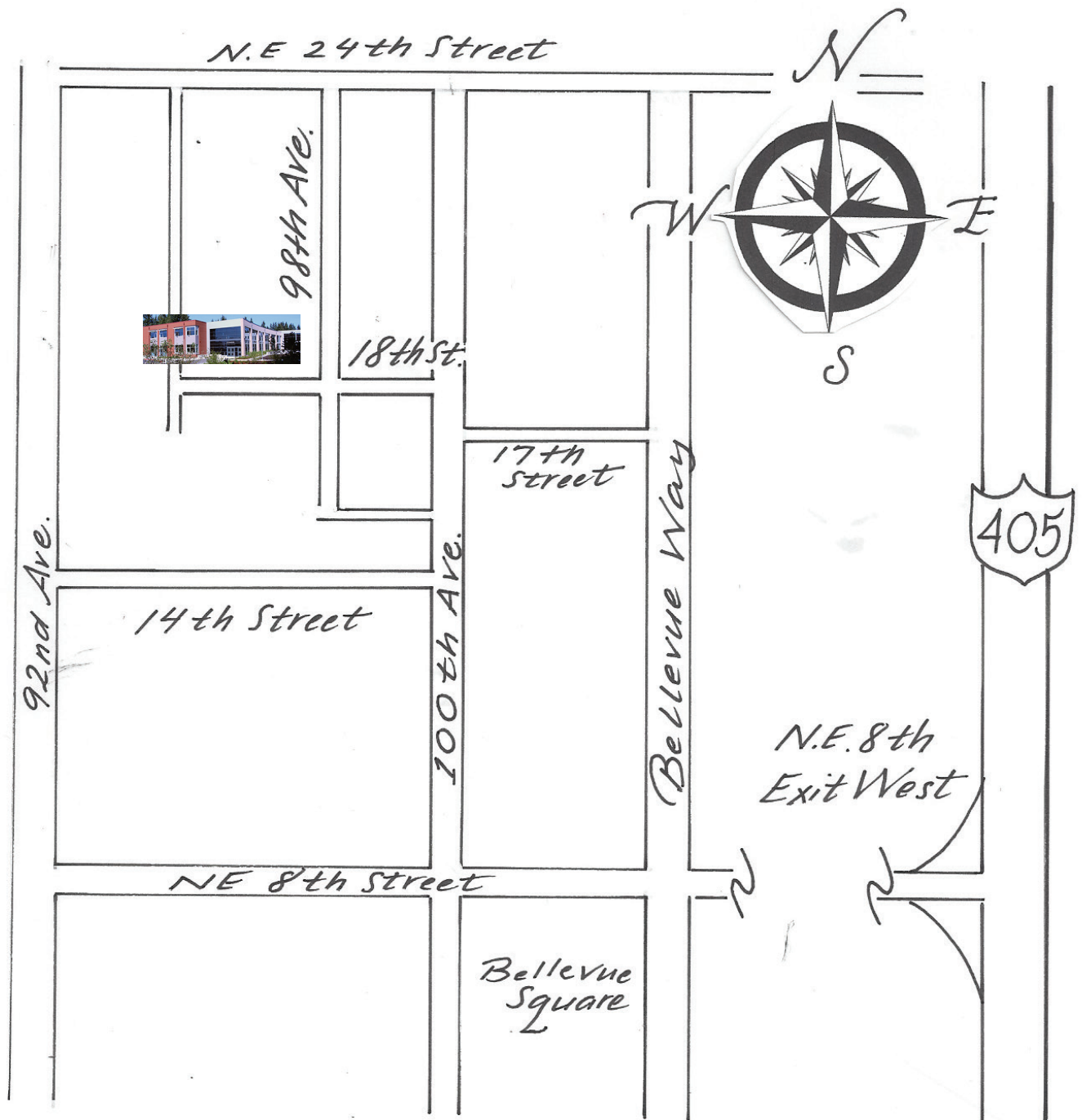

Meetings in Winter-Spring 2019

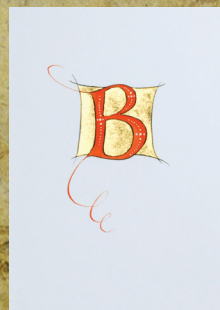
January 17 Meeting: Cadels with Kathy Barker

Originating in the 15th century, Cadels are beautifully decorated letters that are a delight to the eye yet deceptively simple to create. In this evening program, we will look at samples of both historic and contemporary Cadels. Next, we will have a chance to learn some basic patterns. From this exercise we see how to use a base letter and transform it into a Cadel.

A Touch of Gold - Different surfaces such as wood, paper and even chocolate become extraordinary when gilded. We will make a gift tag, place card and greeting card using gold leaf and gold inks & powders.
