

TIM BOTTS studied graphic design and calligraphy at Carnegie-Mellon University. He designed more than 600 books during his 40 years at Tyndale House Publishers before retiring in 2012. Since 1975 he has taught calligraphy with College of DuPage. He is artistic director for Masterpiece Project, an outreach to high school students in the arts. Ten books



of his own work are published including *Doorposts*, *Portraits of the Word*, and *Bound for Glory*. Tim and his wife Nancy live in Glen Ellyn, Illinois and are the parents of three children and 14 grandchildren. For prints of more than 300 of his works, please visit timbottscalligraphy.com

We will begin with a slide talk retrospective of my work in calligraphy. I will demonstrate uncial letterforms, one of the oldest styles of our alphabet and one of the simplest and friendliest. Then you will have a chance to practice writing it. In the afternoon. I will begin by demonstrating a large word picture of a quotation, talking through my design process as I work through it. Afterward I will give you a series of exercises to do in class to experience different ways of expressing the meaning of words.

A calligraphic marker and lined paper will be provided with no other supplies needed.
